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About organization:

BhagwaanManav kalian Samiti (BMKS)- is a civil society organization established in 2000 by a group of social activist after brainstorming and need assessment of the Mau district where the community people were deprived from all type of development indicators. The Organisation was further registered under Society act in 2002.

The organization is working on Empowering the community through people participation by developing community based organization (CBOs) of women the major beneficiaries as well as the agent of social change, to cover the Women and children from deprived community through Women empowerment, Health(maternal health, Literacy, and livelihood. Presently organization is working in entire GPs of Ghosi Block. Organization has its strong faith on the principle of working of Mother Teresa, Mahatma Gandhi, swami vivekanand and pandit Madan Mohan malviya.

About program

Brief background: BMKS has been implementing Empowerment of Rural

poor (ERW) **Program** and Community Health Program Ghosi Block of Mau district with the support of tata trusts. The Projects have ensured to implementation of different community awareness and mobilization events in the intervention areas. It was 14th February 2016 where during a meetings with Nari Sangh enthusiasm was auestions and raised by a physically challenges member Nari sangh name



Saimunisa. She was 80% Physically Challenged since birth. She narrated that "every women has many options of livelihood in this meeting and accordingly are being suggested but is there are any option for people like me who are physically challenged?." The secretary of

BMKS asked what type of support you need to initiate a livelihood option. She asked a support for sewing machine to start stitching and tailoring.

The demand was further shared in coordination committee of BMKS and was decided to provide a sewing machine to the women through local contribution and crowd fundraising efforts. This was pilot and the committee decided to identify such more women in the block and provide them support to initiate the livelihood option and generate the self dignity among such women. It was expected that women will produce shopping bags, workshop bags, Medicine bags etc. It was also decided to lead a campaign to avoid the plastic bags.

Goal and Objectives of initiatives:

Overall goal

to ensure a self dependent and stigma free life of physically challenged

Objectives

- To identify the physically challenged women and promote skill development among them as well as linkages for earning.
- To ensure a healthy life of polio affected people through their referral and treatments.
- To cover each physically challenged people through social security and benefits schemes and facilitate them to access their rights.

Key strategy

- Need assessment of physically challenged.
- Identification of skill potential among the identified.
- Organizing skill development trainings for the physically challenged.
- Involving Nari Sangh as facilitator of physically challenged women in their development initiatives.
- Referral and linkages with departments, PRIs, MPs,MLA, and other concerned authorities.

Core Activities

- Baseline of Physically challenged and preparation of line listing
- Categorize the beneficiaries based on their status.
- Online registration of each Divyang.
- Linkages with line departments and organizing camp for issuing the certificate.
- Facilitation to access the pension schemes for each physically challenged.
- Organizing open gram Sabha through facilitation of Nari sangh and put the issue of divyang in the meeting.
- Running the skill development center and providing the vocational trainings to each divyang like Stitching, Computer course, beautician courses and electronic etc
- Celebration of" Physically Challenged Day" on 3rd December.
- Facilitate and referral of Polio affected people to higher health institutions.

Program profile

It was 13th March 2016, the International women's day celebration week. The Program was

inaugurated in Junior High School Ghosi by Dr Neelam Kushwaha the Director of Navjeewan Hospital – Ghosi and Ms Archana Upadhyay. The 15 divyaang women were give a sewing machine. During the Program Dr Ak Singh from SAI Hospital said that in current society the physiaccly challenged are being discriminated in many ways so in such circumstances the organization effort is remarkable. We will support all possible to



make this program successful. Dr Neelam Kushwaha also put her views and told that there is a need to sensitize the community and people to support the such women to link them in mainstream of society. The Block Pramukh of Ghosi Mr. Sujeet Kumar Singh said that today the women are coming front in every areas and taking initiative. "I will support every women of such cases in every govt. schemes. The trainings of such women will be organized at block

level" In the continuation of speech Mrs archana Upadhayay the member of SC/ST Commission told that today Divyang women are facing many problems and discriminations. And BMKS's effort will make changes in these families. By this Program the Divyang women will be encouraged to do more for themselves. This is really and very good efforts to empower the women. In the end of the Program The Director of BMKS Mrs. Poonam Singh focused on the expected outcome of the Program. Informed that Organisation is encouraging and facilitating in Organizing open gram sabha ,Advocacy meetings with block and District level, Facilitation of access to maternal and child health as well as educational needs. The Program is to generate the self dignity among Divyang women and link them in mainstream of society. She told that there is a plan to cover more than 100 Such women through the DSP Program.

The treasurer of Organization paid the vote of thanks to the participants.

Initial effort to run the program activities

To make the way to support the women more and more ,the several fundraising activities

were planned and ensured during the DSP initiative. The BMKS mobilized Community influencer ,social workers , Shopkeepers ,PRIs and other people to provide sup[port in the program. Donation boxes were developed and crowd fundraising were also held. The Workers of BMKS collected the money from local Hatt and Bazaar also .


